No.NBE-3/Ex-Misc(10)/2016-17/702 dated 28th March 2015 and No.NBE-3/Ex-Misc(10)/2016-17/600 dated 2nd April 2016, it is hereby notified **once again** that registered schools should not issue Transfer Certificates to students who have not qualified the Class IX Final Examination.

The unhealthy practice of the schools denying readmission to those students in their respective schools is against the interest of the students.

Therefore, all registered schools are hereby informed and directed to **avoid** such practices. Schools should take positive steps to help the students and see that the interest of the student is given priority.

Appropriate departmental action shall be initiated against schools adopting such unhealthy practices.
