2. Hornbill School, Chekiye Village, Dimapur.

The period of withdrawal of recognition shall be effective for a minimum period of 3 (three) years. Fresh provisional recognition shall be considered subject to fulfillment of the conditions laid down by the Board.

However, if the school does not show any improvement within 2 (two) years after withdrawal of recognition, further action shall be taken to withdraw the permission of the school to run Class IX & X.

**Recognised schools must ensure the enrolment criteria i.e. minimum 20 students in each class from Class VI to X.**


