Subject:- **Financial Markets Management (FMM) course in Higher Secondary Level**

Sir/Madam,

Nagaland Board of School Education introduced Financial Markets Management course in Higher Secondary level for Commerce Stream in collaboration with the National Stock Exchange of India Limited from the academic session 2014 in a phase manner. However, acknowledging the importance of the subject for everyone irrespective of stream/ background, the Board had extended to offer the course to Arts Stream from the academic session 2018.

The course consists of 1 (one) paper each which is offered as an elective subject in both Class XI & XII. The course fee is ₹ 700/- for class XI and ₹ 1,200/- for class XII which is inclusive of study materials such as text book, NLT software for practical and Online examination fees. Students who opt for the course undergo two examinations (i.e. Board Exam and an Online Examination conducted by the NSE). Students who qualify in both the examinations (i.e. HSSLC Examination and the Online Examination at Class XI and Class XII) are issued a Joint Certificate after passing out the HSSLC Examination in addition to the Board certificates.


Till date, One Hundred Sixty Six (166) had been declared qualified for the Joint Certificate out of which 89 had already received the Joint Certificate and the remaining 77 who passed the HSSLC Examination 2020 will get the Joint Certificate soon.

The Pass percentage of the students appearing the Online Examination 2020 is 64.75%. The average score in the Online Examination of those qualified student for the Joint Certificate is 43.26% in Class XI paper and 58.51% in Class XII paper. The average score for both the paper is 50.89%.

So far, the Board is very impressed with the performance of the students and the avenues which lies ahead for the takers of the course. However, presently we have only very few schools offering the course in the schools.

Therefore, the Board would like to encourage more schools to come forward by introducing the course and provide more option for the students so that more students can venture into the financial world.
